- 4.3 BPS Request for Objective Review Update

On December 3, 2015, Section VI received the following letter from Aubrey Lloyd, Director of Athletics for Buffalo Public Schools:

On behalf of the Buffalo Board of Education, Superintendent Dr. Kriner A. Cash, and Bennett High School parents and community members, please accept this letter as a formal request for an objective review of the Bennett High School vs. Maple Grove Class C Championship Football game that occurred on November 9, 2015 at Ralph Wilson Stadium. This request is being made to determine if the officiating substantially contributed to the outcome of the game.

As was decided by the Executive Committee, Section VI replied to A. Lloyd indicating that the request will be formally referred to the Southwestern Chapter NYS Association of Certified Football Officials Inc. and the WNY Chapter of NYS Association of Certified Football Officials Inc. On January 7th, 2016, T. Slade held a meeting with the representatives from both officials' organizations to inform them of the request and the Section's response.

It was decided that representatives of both football officials groups would review the tape of the Class C Championship Football game, Bennett vs. Maple Grove, held at Ralph Wilson Stadium, November 9, 2015. A report, indicating the individuals who conducted the objective review, will be submitted by January 22, 2016 to T. Slade. P. Trzybinski volunteered to be the lead representative in conducting the objective review of the tape and responsible for the submission of the report to T. Slade.

4.4 Indoor Track & Field

A Section VI member school, which does not have an indoor track team, participated in a Section V Indoor Track and Field event. T. Slade is currently investigating the specifics of the incident in order to determine appropriate penalties. T. Slade will update the committee as more information becomes available.

4.5 Workers' Compensation

Resulting from a recent audit, the Section's workers' compensation insurance carrier, NYS Insurance Fund, added sports officials to the policy at a premium of \$20,000. The Section maintains its position that sports officials are independent contractors and as such, are not eligible for workers' compensation. Without receipt by NYS Insurance Fund of the charges owed, the Section's policy will be cancelled. Attorneys from Goldberg Segalla advised the Section to not pay the NYS Insurance Fund's charges pertaining to sports officials as employers are not required, by state law, to purchase coverage for independent contractors. As suggested by Goldberg Segalla, D. Scholla will contact Lawley Insurance for coverage.

6.1.1 Fall 2015 End of Season Reports

The Combining of Schools Committee met Thursday, January 14, 2016 to review the fall 2015 end of season reports. The committee recommends to decline future potential requests for combination of the following teams:

- Maple Grove/Chautauqua Lake in Football, 2016-2017
 The recommendation for declination is based on dominance. Combining will be considered, however, if moved up a classification.
- Olmsted/Alt Ed./Bennett in Football, 2016-2017
 The recommendation for declination is based on dominance. Combining will be considered, however, if moved up a classification.
- 3. IPrep/DaVinci/Lafayette/East/Performing Arts/Riverside in Football, 2016-2017
 The recommendation for declination is based on the previously approved criteria. The present combination exceeds the maximum number of schools (4) allowed to combine.

Dependent upon formal requests to combine of the aforementioned and subsequent declinations of those applications, host schools may submit an appeal to the Section VI Executive Committee in person.

6.2.3 Girls Golf

The 2016, 2017, and 2018 Girls Golf State Championships will be held at Bethpage on Long Island. Travel has not been an issue in the past when scheduled at Delhi, but this may change with the new venue. Currently, Section VI covers expenses for meals and hotel rooms for the student-athletes and coaches. T. Slade notified member schools that, if requested, the Section could schedule a coach bus for all participants and coaches. The Section would then back bill each member school in order to avoid violation of the approved travel policy. Member schools were asked to respond, indicating their preference, by Wednesday December 16, 2015.

A majority of the schools involved are in favor of the Section securing transportation for the 2016, 2017, and 2018 Girls Golf state championships.

As recommended by the Section VI Finance Committee, approval will be requested at the following athletic council meeting for Section VI to secure transportation, to and from Bethpage (Long Island), for all Girls Golf 2016, 2017, and 2018 state championships' participants and coaches and back bill each member school involved.

6.2.4 Chenille Patches

The 2016-2017 proposed Section VI budget includes pulling the purchase of the awards (line item) from the Erie 1 BOCES bid process. The purchase and payment of the awards would then be made directly by Section VI. The rationale being that Section VI has done business with the same vendor (Trophys Trophys) for several years as they have consistently submitted the lowest bid.

Trophys Trophys recently contacted T. Slade informing him that if Section VI places their 2016-2017 chenille patches order by January 15, 2016, a discount in the amount of \$1,200 will be given towards the purchase.

As recommended by the Section VI Finance Committee, approval will be requested at the following athletic council meeting to purchase the 2016-2017 chenille patches from Trophys Trophys at a savings of \$1,200 pending approval of the proposed 2016-2017 Section VI budget.

At the December 2015 meeting, the NYSPHSAA Championship Philosophy Committee announced its opposition to the 6 classification proposal (in any sport). According to the NYSPHSAA Championship Philosophy, Guidelines, and Process; the percentage of opportunities for athletes to compete in NYSPHSAA Championships should fall within a designated range of 5% to 8% for all sports.
