# Section VI Girls Wrestling Championship 2025 Postseason Information & Procedures

**Date:** Friday, February 14th 2025 **Location:** Sweet Home High School

Championship Entry Information Due: Sunday, February 9, 10:00am

Weigh-ins / Skin Check: 12:30 PM (wrestling room)

Doors Open: 2:15 PM

Wrestling Starts: 2:30 (3 mats)

**Finals:** 7:30 PM (1 mat)

\*The wrestling room will serve as the weigh-in, staging, and warm-up area for all athletes. All bags and other team belongings must stay in this room and out of the bleachers. We will provide room security to manage traffic going in and out. A video board or speaker will be placed in this room for upcoming bouts.

- a. Tournament will wrestle back to four places w/ a true second if necessary, following the finals.
- b. If a wrestler loses in the round of sixteen their opponent must make the semifinals to remain in the competition and wrestleback.
- c. Team scoring at the Sectionals will be kept as a way to determine our team champion. All thirteen wrestlers can score even if two are in a weight class.
- d. Most outstanding Wrestler will be awarded
- e. If a wrestler misses their official entered weight at the weigh-in February 14th, they are out of the sectional tournament.
- f. In the event of a scratch after the seeds are out and the tournament is drawn, we will roll the seeds and redraw the bracket.
- q. 1st and 3rd place matches in each weight class will not be run together.

### **Tournament Entries Criteria:**

COMMON SENSE will be one way that we determine the qualifying field and seeding of the Section VI Girls 2025 Wrestling Championship. Other determining factors will be the (a) USA Wrestling's Performance Index Rating (PIN) (b) recent head-to-head; (c) season record; (d) most technical falls; (e) most wins; (f) highest win percentage; (g) most pins (h) 2024-2025 tournament placing, (i) the number of matches this season. In no particular order.

The following are the weight classes set by the NYSPHSAA Committee for the 24-25 season: 94, 100, 107, 114, 120, 126, 132, 138, 145, 152, 165, 185, 235

- 1. A 16 girl bracket will be used in each weight class to qualify for the Section VI Championship tournament.
- 2. The top eight girls in each weight class will be seeded from highest seed #1 to lowest seed #8 The remaining wrestlers will be randomly drawn into the bracket
- 3. To be eligible for the Section VI girls championship tournament each contestant must have represented their school and wrestled in at least two separate scheduled girls freestyle contests of the six that are required for postseason competition.
- 4. Each team can submit a maximum of 13 wrestlers for entry into the championship. You can submit one wrestler per weight or a maximum of two per weight to make up your 13 total entries.

Once all entries from each team have been submitted we will select the top 16 girls in the 13 weight classes to complete the bracket.

## Submitting your tournament entries and procedure:

- Your wrestlers are entered into the tournament by completing the attached excel document. List your thirteen tournament participants and complete the required fields.
- 2. ALL COACHES MUST SUBMIT A COMPLETE AND UP TO DATE NYSPHSAA RECORD FORM for each wrestler entered prior to the seeding of the Sectional tournament (Printed from TrackWrestling). They must also submit a weigh in sheet from TrackWrestling showing that their entries are eligible for the weight class.
- 3. ALL documents listed in #1 and #2 above must be submitted by email to <a href="mailto:thomasshifflet@gmail.com">thomasshifflet@gmail.com</a> AND <a href="mailto:browe@ripleycsd.org">browe@ripleycsd.org</a> by Sunday, February, 9th 10:00am. Any school / coach whose entries are not received by 10:00am on Sunday February 9th will not be eligible for the 2025 Girls Section VI Wrestling Championship February 14th. At this time no changes to weight class or your entries will be made.
- 4. All wrestlers by weight class will be emailed to each coach to confirm the information is accurate
- 5. The tournament participants and preseeds will be determined and emailed to each coach for review and requests for any change. Any requests for review should be emailed to <a href="mailto:thomasshifflet@gmail.com">thomasshifflet@gmail.com</a> no later than Monday, February 10th at 5:00 PM
- Requests for changes to the selected participants or seeds will be reviewed and the process will be complete. The final list of participants and seeds will be emailed to the coaches.
- 7. Brackets will be drawn after the weigh-ins on Friday, February, 14.
- 8. The section chairman has the ability to add a wrestler(s) to the tournament field if a scratch occurs prior to the official weigh-in.

.ALL COACHES MUST SUBMIT a COMPLETE AND UP TO DATE NYSPHSAA RECORD FORM for each wrestler entered prior to the seeding of the Sectional tournament (Printed from TrackWrestling). They must also submit a weigh in sheet from TrackWrestling showing that their entries are eligible for the weight class. To be eligible for sectional or state competition, contestants in individual sports must have represented their school in six (6) scheduled contests. The required contests must occur on six different dates and must be concluded prior to the conclusion of the team's regular season. A "forfeit" counts as a contest as long as the named wrestler is listed (as winning by forfeit) in the TrackWrestling results for that contest.

Therefore, NO wrestler should be entered with fewer than 6 different contests listed on their NYS record form heading into the postseason, unless the Section grants a wrestler a "minimum contests waiver". Before a wrestler can be entered into the Sectional Tournament, the coach must submit a complete and up-to-date NYS District Reporting Record Form as provided by the TrackWrestling website that is signed by both the coach and the participating wrestler by Sunday, February 9, 10:00 am. All Schools are strongly encouraged to complete all regular season dual matches by February 8, 2025.
